



Hilton Habitat Sharecrow Assembly Instructions



It is recommended to have at least 2 adult volunteers plus the teacher available for this project. Assembly can be done in the pavilion or inside if weather is poor.

Frames for sharecrows are in the shed (lock combination is 0-22-32).

Procedure

- dress frame, use twine suspenders up and over the frame to help support pants
- stuff with newspaper
- insert sock in legs, gloves in wrists
- tie wrists and ankles with twine
- pin shirt to pants
- add jug head (upside down milk jug with a mouth opening cut into the side)
- locate scarecrow in Habitat
- pound stake into ground with mallet (in shed hanging on pegboard)
- secure to fence or tree if additional support is needed
- dress with scarf, hat, strings of goodies, birdseed in the mouth
- stuff a little straw here & there for effect

Keep extra cheerios, string, etc. in the classroom for use during indoor recess. Sharecrows remain in the Habitat all winter and can be replenished with food at any time.
